'70s



Size unknown



1975

Reportedly a backpatch, this is the earliest known patch issued by the Fraternity. It features a red outline of Fort Schuyler with an Eagle and fleur-de-lis, anchor, propeller, the training ship and the words "EAGLE SCOUT FRATERNITY". The words "MARITIME COLLEGE 1975 FORT SCHUYLER N.Y". ring the outside border.

1979

This patch resembles the 1975 back patch. A non-fully embroidered patch with a blue canvas background with "MARITIME COLLEGE 1979 SCOUT-O-RAMA" in gold lettering. A red outline of Fort Schuyler fills the center that contains an Eagle, fleur-de-lis, anchor, propeller, TSES V and the words "EAGLE SCOUT".

1980

A non fully-embroidered patch, the 1980 Scout-o-rama has a white anchor with a long anchor chain with a gold fleur-de-lis centered on a blue background.





1983

A non fully-embroidered patch with the words "MARITIME COLLEGE SCOUT-A-RAMA" and two gold fleur-de-lis' around the border. Centered is an outline of the TSES with 1983 in the middle. This is imposed over an anchor and a propeller with the letters "N" and "Y" on two of the blades.



1987

A white canvas patch with an orange border. "SUNRISE DISTRICT FALL CAMPOREE SUNY NYMMA" in black letters circles the border. In the center is a tall ship with the year 1987. Below the ship are an anchor, fleur-di-lis and the image of a Cadet shaking hands with a Scout in uniform. This version features thick lettering.



1987

This version features thin lettering. The camporee ran out of patches, and a 2nd order was placed, which came back with thinner lettering.

1989

This fall camporee patch for the Sunrise District featured a Scout in uniform with a seabag labeled with "NYMMA" on it walking along a dock. A tall ship sits in the background with three seagulls flying above.

This camporee patch features a brown lettering on a light blue field. The words "SUNY MARITIME COLLEGE PEQUOTT 1989 CAMPOREE" circle the inside of the border. A ships wheel with a blue fleur-de-lis at North. A white outline of an ocean liner reminiscent of a cruise ship logo sits in the center.

1989

This fall camporee patch for the Eastern District features a gold fleur-de-lis outlined in red centered on a white background. An anchor and 1989 are in the fleur-de-lis. The words "FORT SCHULER EASTERN DISTRICT CAMP-O-REE" circle inside the red border of this patch.

1991

This camporee patch for Pequott District, part of Theodore Roosevelt Council, features black lettering for the works PEQUOTT MARITIME CAMPOREE 1991 on a yellow background. A red FDL and crossed anchors sits in the middle of the patch.

1995

This camporee patch features a ship with the words "NYSMA" and SUNY on the hull in the center. A dock with 1995 in red is below the ship while an island with a lighthouse is above it. Two clouds contain the lettered "BACK ON THE WATERFRONT" and "SUNRISE DISTRICT CAMPOREE".

1996

Suffolk County Council's Nathaniel Woodhull district's 1996 fall camporee featured an eagle over two flags with a shield containing a red FDL all on a white background. The words "NATHANIEL WOODHULL FALL CAMPOREE FORT SCHUYLER 1996" are in red with a yellow border.

2001

For the 2001 camporee patch – the center is a blue field with the outline of Fort Schuyler in red, an Eagle, fleur–de–lis, anchor, propeller, TSES and the words "EAGLE SCOUT FRATERNITY". The words "MARITIME COLLEGE 1975 FORT SCHUYLER N.Y." ring the outside of the blue field, and 2001 is embroidered in white. A red border surrounds this with the words "ANNUAL SPRING CAMPOREE AT SUNY MARITIME COLLEGE".

Circa 2001

More information is needed about this patch. It is possible it was an error or sew-out. It is unclear if this patch was ever issued. The 2001 is missing from the blue field and "SUNY" is misspelled as "SUNNY".



2002

The 2002 patch sports a slightly different design with the outline of For Schuyler imposed over an American flag with "2002", "1975" and "Fort Schuyler, N.Y." in gold lettering on a dark blue field. In the surrounding red ring is "MARITIME COLLEGE SPRING CAMPOREE"



2002

A second version of the 2002 camporee patch exists replacing the "T" in Maritime with a screw.



2007

The 2007 patch is nearly identical to the 2001 patch, with the exception of brighter gold thread and the numbers "2007" below the outline of Fort Schuyler.



2008

The 2008 patch is nearly identical to the 2001 patch, with the exception of brighter gold thread and the number "2008" below the outline of Fort Schuyler.



2009

A yellow rope forms the border on this patch, with a blue inner circle ringed in an anchor chain containing the Maritime prop and anchor. The outer ring with a red background contains the words "SUNY MARITIME COLLEGE EAGLE SCOUT FRATERNITY" in in black.



2010

A yellow rope forms the border on this patch, with a blue inner circle with "NEW YORK MARITIME COLLEGE EAGLE SCOUT FRATERNITY" in white. In a light blue inner circle are the words 2010 and CAMPOREE with a FDL over an anchor.



Size unknown



2013

A yellow rope forms the border on this patch. In the blue and red fields within the circle are the FDL, modern Maritime College "M", an anchor and a propellor. The words "NEW YORK MARITIME COLLEGE EAGLE SCOUT FRATERNITY CAMPOREE" circle just inside the border. There is no year on the patch, but this was used for the 2013 camporee.

2014

The 2014 patch is identical to the 2013 patch with "2014" added in white. 200 of these were produced.

2015

The 2015 patch features an outline of the five sided Fort Schuyler, a golden anchor, and the Maritime "M" logo in Crimson & White. The Fleur-di-lis is positioned at the anchor crown. 200 of these were produced. 200 of these were produced.



2016

The patch distributed at the 2016 camporee is a mirror image of the previous year sans "2015". 200 of these were produced.

'10s

2018

No 2018 patch was ever made for this year's camporee. Various designs were created at the time, but none were ever produced.

2019

The *Training Ship Empire State VI* was featured because it will only serve the college for a few more years before retirement. 200 of these were produced.

2020

The Fort was emphasized this year because the training ship was likely to be in drydock during the camporee. A few weeks before the event, the camporee was cancelled due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. 300 of these were produced.

2022

The sun setting on the Training Ship Empire State VI is symbolic of the ship's final activation for the 2022 Summer Sea Term before its retirement later that year. Manufactured with a 100% recycled plastic backing. 200 of these were produced.





2023

A sunrise embraces the college's new training ship, purpose built as National Security Multi-Mission Vessel (NSMV), as it sails under the Throggs Neck Bridge. 325 of these were produced.
